Interchangeable names

Jean, Jane, Jeanie, Jessie or Janet Morag, Sarah Donald, Daniel Hamish, James Peter, Patrick Grace, Grizel Christina, Christian Ian/Iain, John, Jack, Jock Callum, Malcolm Todd, George

1st daughter named after mother's mother

2nd daughter named after father's mother

3rd daughter named after her own mother
